

THE MG CAR CLUB (AUCKLAND CENTRE) INC. CLASSIC MARATHON 2010

Event Regulations

1. ANNOUNCEMENT & JURISDICTION:

This event will be known as "The Classic Marathon" and is promoted and organised by the MG Car Club (Auckland Centre) Inc., PO Box 6483, Auckland. The event is open to all cars as below.

2. ELIGIBILITY:

Standard production and modified road-going saloon, sports and GT cars. Cars must be of a clean and tidy condition. All cars are accepted at the sole discretion of the organisers.

3. ROUTE:

The route will be of approximately 350 miles (approximately 600 kilometres) over selected public back-country roads through the South Auckland, Waikato and King Country regions. The navigation methods may include simple tulip diagrams, straight line maps and touring sections using trial-type instructions.

4. DATE OF EVENT:

The event begins on Saturday 2 October and will end on Sunday 3 October 2010.

5. INDEMNITY:

An indemnity must be signed by all car owners, drivers and co-drivers. Drivers under 18 years of age must have their entry form signed by a parent or guardian.

6. ENTRY ACCEPTANCE and FINAL INSTRUCTIONS:

Acceptance, or otherwise, as an entrant on the Classic Marathon 2010 will be notified within two weeks of receipt of your completed entry. Final instructions will be sent out after the closing date, which is Tuesday 31 August 2010.

7. ENTRIES:

There is a maximum of fifty (50) cars for this event. Entries must be on the form provided and received by the organisers by 5.00pm, Tuesday 31 August 2010. Late entries will be considered if the maximum entry number has not been reached. All entries are accepted at the sole discretion of the organisers. Telephone entries will be placed on a reserve list. Your early entry is advised and appreciated.
