

## Proposed Amendments to the Rules of MG Car Club Auckland Centre Inc

### Amendment #1 Categories of Membership 5.2 (b) Ordinary Members

Amend 5.2 (b) by deleting the number "15" and substituting with the number "20"; and by deleting the words "Ordinary Members who have attained the age of 15 years but not 18 years shall be entitled to vote but not hold office"; and by deleting the words "who have attained the age of 18 years"

Current Wording	Proposed Wording
5.2 b " <b>ORDINARY MEMBERS</b> " shall be persons aged <del>15</del> years or over who subscribe hereto upon such terms and subject to such criteria as the Committee may from time to time determine, who have been accepted pursuant to these Rules as financial Members of the Club. <del>Ordinary Members who have attained the age of 15 years but not 18 years shall be entitled to vote but not hold office.</del> Ordinary Members <del>who have attained the age of 18 years</del> shall be entitled to vote and hold office.	5.2 b " <b>ORDINARY MEMBERS</b> " shall be persons aged 20 years or over who subscribe hereto upon such terms and subject to such criteria as the Committee may from time to time determine, who have been accepted pursuant to these Rules as financial Members of the Club. Ordinary Members shall be entitled to vote and hold office.

#### Rationale:

By extending free membership to those aged between 15 to 20 years is a way to encourage potential members in the 15 to 20 age group to apply for Youth Membership to the Club.

### Amendment #2 Categories of Membership 5.2 (c) Junior Members

Amend Categories of Membership 5,2 (c) by deleting the word "Junior" in both the title and wording and substituting with the word "Youth"; and by deleting the number "15" and substituting with the number "20"

Youth Members shall not be entitled to vote or hold office.

#### Rationale:

To encourage those between the age of 15 through to 20 years to make application for free membership of the "Youth Members" category. By changing the word "Junior" to "Youth" better reflects the age-related terminology of young people.

Youth Members shall not be entitled to vote or hold office.
