Visit Taupo

Taupo is one of New Zealand's tourist meccas, there's lots to choose from during your down time – Visit Taupo (<u>link</u>) has some great suggestions, here's our picks:

Aratiatia Rapids (<u>link</u>): a must see on your visit to Taupo. Watch thousands of litres of water rush from the dam gates to transform the peaceful gully into raging rapids.

Huka Falls (<u>link</u>): At Huka Falls you can witness the phenomenon of natural hydro power with more than 220,000 litres of water per sec barrelling over 11meter high waterfall.

Visit Geothermal hot pools: There are many options available, including Wairakei Terraces & Thermal Health Spa (<u>link</u>). Embrace the healing benefits of geothermal and mineral rich water.

The Octagonal Spotlight - Feature MG - Bryce Gliddon's MGA FHC

Bryce and Marion Gliddon are long time member of the MG Car Club with their wonderful black MGA FHC. It's a well known car in NZ, having done all manner of events from racing through to touring social events.

The car arrived in Christchurch New Zealand from USA in 1962 as a LHD. Probable owner an Operation Deep Freeze employee.

Bryce purchased the car in 1983 as a rusty wreck which had been lying in a paddock at Kaukapakapa. Full restoration was completed by 1995.

It has subsequently undergone numerous fast road modifications - a very well modified 1800cc MGB engine, 5-speed gearbox, 3.9:1 diff and uprated suspension and brakes - but retained the character of the MGA, not to mention it's stunning good looks. Keep a look out for it on the Rally - probably going very quickly passed you!
